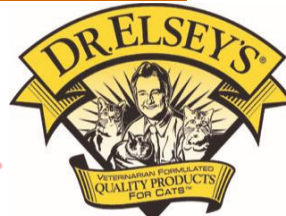

Exhibition £30 for up to 2 days (double space - 2 cats or 3 kittens)				
Payment on the door MUST be arranged in advance, in writing, with the Entry Clerk/Show manager-a £5 surcharge will apply. If an arrangement is not made, a Tardy Turtle fee will apply, along with the surcharge				
Tardy Turtle - payment after closing date - £10 per cat				
Substitution fee - show manager's discretion (up to closing date only) - £10 per cat

Checking in – Sat 8 - 8.45 Sun 8.30 – 9.00

Exhibitors must check in both days in order for absentee lists to be compiled for the judges

Judging is from 9.00am to 4.30pm sat/9.30am – 4.30pm sun. Cats may not leave the show hall prior to the advertised hours without the show manager's consent.

Health requirements – this is a **non-vetted** show. Up to date vaccination cards must be produced at check in. The show manager reserves the right to remove any cat showing any signs of illness, mites, fleas, fungal infections etc. in accordance with TICA rules. Cats from household where there has been an infectious disease/fungal infection within 21 days of the first day of the show are ineligible for entry. Any cat obviously pregnant or lactating will be disqualified. All claws, front & back, must be clipped prior to judging.

Benching – **This is a “bring your own pen” show.** Double SPACES (4ft x 2ft x 2ft) will be supplied by the club. There is a limited supply of metal pens on a “first come, first served” basis, which may be hired at £10 for 1 or 2 days. Benching requests should be made with the entry, however no guarantee is made. Litter bins will be provided but exhibitors are requested to bag their rubbish before placing in the bins. Exhibitors should supply their own litter trays, litter, cat food & water.

Airports – Manchester/Doncaster//East Midlands & Leeds. The nearest airport operating the PETS system is Manchester. The club is unable to offer transport.

Confirmations – It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to check the confirmation slips issued – please check carefully. If you do not receive a confirmation e-mail before the closing date for entries, please contact the entry clerk.

Catering – there is catering in the show hall from 8.00 am

Clerking/assistance – if you are able to clerk or help in any way please e-mail the show managers. Clerks will be paid £30 per day. All clerks will receive lunch

Kittens – Any kitten entered must be at least 4 calendar months but less than 8 calendar months on the date of show. Neutered kittens may be entered.

Household pets – HHP's over 8 months of age must be neutered or spayed.

EW Regional Fund – a donation per cat will be made to the Western Europe Regional Fund. Additional funds are gratefully accepted

Registration – with the exception of New Breeds & New Traits, registration with TICA is not required to compete in a cat's first show. However, registration is required for confirmation of titles and scoring for TICA Regional & International awards.

Show rules – TICA show rules will be strictly enforced. By entering all exhibitors agree to abide by the decisions of the judges and show committee. The official show rules may be obtained from \$7.00 from TICA, PO Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551 or www.tica.org
